I have been working with Vanamar Constructors for almost three years on two projects; Victoria Heights in New Westminster and Wexford Creek in Nanaimo. The construction values in each project vary between \$15 - \$20 million and the construction timeline approximately 1 ½ years each. Victoria Heights was a complicated project in that it has two health clinics and a children's day care all combined with our assisted living building. The site is small, sloped and challenging, and the building meets LEED® criteria.
